

Osi Rhys Osmond Art Prize 2022

Osi Rhys Osmond, who lived in Llansteffan for 30 years before his death in 2015, was an internationally known artist, broadcaster, teacher and author. An Honorary member of the Gorsedd of Bards, one of his paintings was given as a gift from Wales to the Flemish parliament. Osi was an inspirational man who enthused all who met him with his energy and his love for individual human endeavour and achievement.

This Art Competition, to commemorate Osi's name, has been arranged in conjunction with the Carmarthen School of Art, where Osi was for many years head of the Foundation Course. Entries were encouraged from all current students of the college. By exhibiting the work in the village it will promote arts and culture locally, while providing an opportunity for the artists to have their work appreciated by a wider public.

The theme chosen for this year's competition is "We talk, think, dream and stare" which is a line taken from a poem by Osi called "Correspondence" that is reproduced below.

Bydd arddangos y gwaith yn y pentref yn hybu'r celfyddydau a diwylliant yn lleol tra hefyd yn creu'r cyfle i gynulleidfa ehangach gwerthfawrogi talentau'r myfyrwyr.

Gwahoddwyd gwaith celf ar y thema "We talk, think, dream and stare", llinell gan Osi yn ei gerdd "Correspondence" sy'n ymddangos isod.

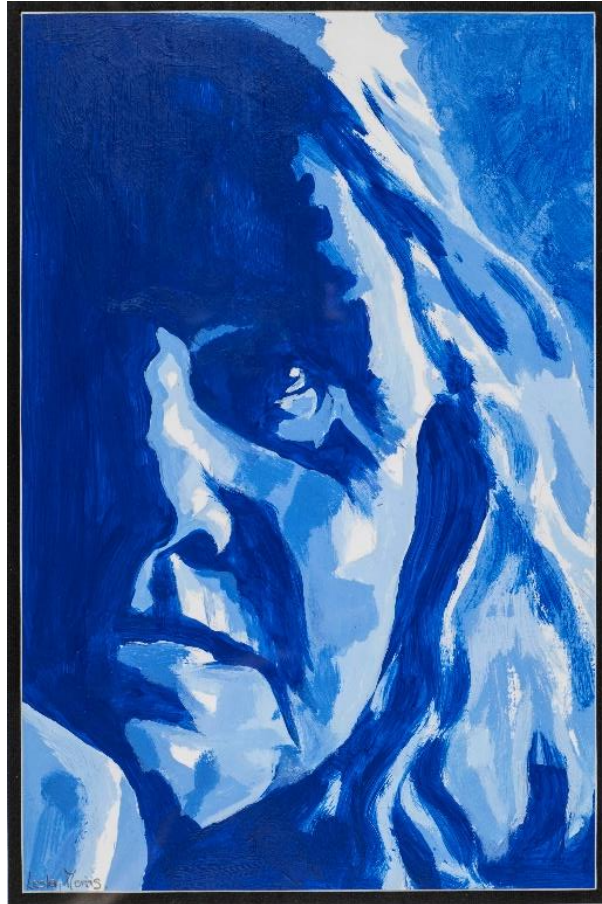
Artist's Statement:

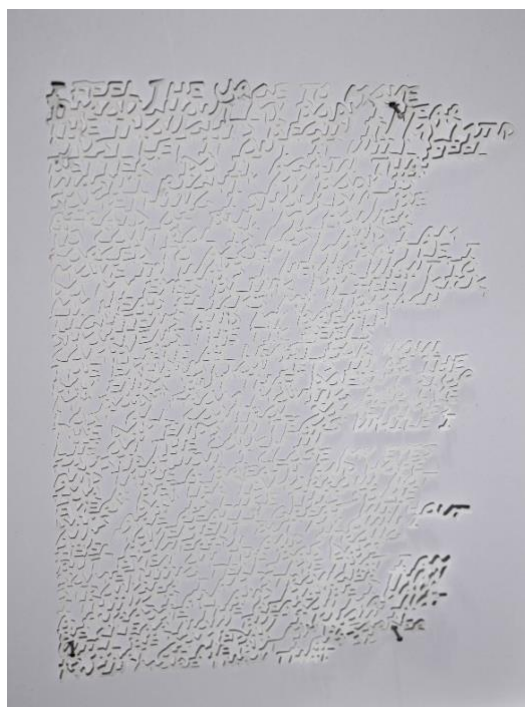
